# Clinical Presentation

A 9-year-old boy presented with complaints of-

- **Headache x 3 years**

Holocranial, gradually progressive, moderate intensity

- **Weakness of Left UL and LL x 3 years**

Gradually progressive weakness, with rapid worsening in the last 6 months

- **Blurring of vision – Bilaterally x 6 months**

# Clinical Examination

- General physical examination and vitals – WNL
- Child was conscious, oriented
- **Positive neurological findings**

Visual Acuity – Rt 6/6, Lt 6/18; Bilateral papilledema

Left UMN facial palsy

Rest cranial nerves – WNL
